The Aqua Coaster water slide offers thrills for the whole family while in Mildura, and on hot days is the ideal place to cool down and have some fun. You'll get a lot of rides during a period of half an hour or an hour, and is great value for money.

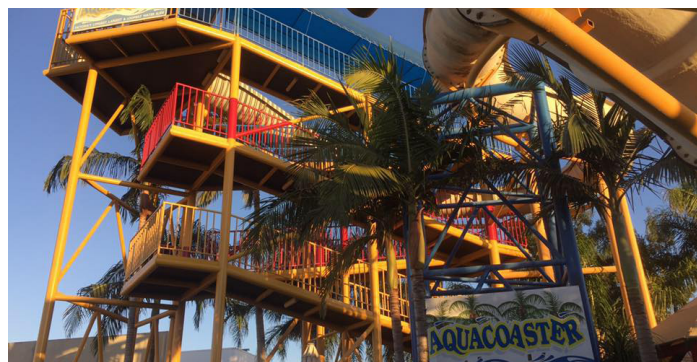

There is a fenced area for young children with a small maze with panels, tunnel, binoculars, musical instruments, abacus, shop front, chain traverse and a little cubby seat plus an echidna springer. There is a separate climbing structure with rope climbing frame and climbing wall, a standalone flying fox, springer, swings, pyramid rope climbing frame and slide.

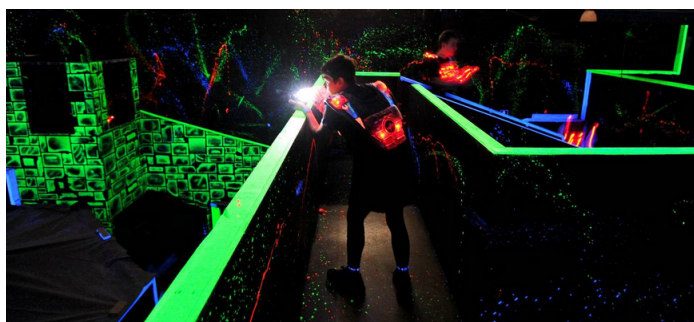

Perry Sandhills

According to geologists, the Perry Sandhills originated after an ice age (40,000 years ago) and were formed by wind erosion over thousands of years. The dunes are a unique land formation of 333 hectares (822 acres) of continuously shifting sand dunes.

Skeletal remains of giant mega-fauna (kangaroos, lions, emus and wombats) have been found there. Replicas of these animals are now on show at the Pioneer Museum in Wentworth. Aboriginal tribes used this area to camp and hunt, and evidence of this is still being uncovered as the sands drift.

Park at the car park and shelter shed at the northern entrance to the Sandhills and climb over the dunes to view the magnificent River Red Gum, named the God Tree, which has been consumed by the sand. Over time, the sand has completely covered the trunk and you can walk within the canopy of the ancient tree.
